

NGO "Civil Holding "GROUP OF INFLUENCE" comprises individuals unified by shared values and a collective mission:






2023 in Numbers

Participation in State Authorities' Coordination Headquarters and Working Groups Meetings

- ▶ Coordination Headquarters for Ensuring the Realization of the Rights and Freedoms of Internally Displaced Persons.
- ▶ Working Group on Employment and Professional Training of Internally Displaced Persons.

2023 in Numbers



Throughout the year **1.16 million** users encountered links to our website in search results.

Major Breakthroughs of 2023

Throughout the year, our team has diligently worked towards ensuring that the government implements necessary solutions to assist individuals affected by the war. Thanks to collaborative efforts with our partners, significant milestones have been achieved:


- The adoption of the **Strategy** of the State Policy on Internal Displacement for the period until 2025, along with the plan of measures for its implementation. This strategy aims to mitigate the negative impact of internal displacement resulting from armed aggression against Ukraine.
- The passage of the **Law of Ukraine** "On Amendments to Certain Laws of Ukraine on Recognition of Educational Qualifications of Persons Residing in the Temporarily Occupied Territory of Ukraine." This legislation introduces mechanisms for validating the educational qualifications of young individuals from the temporarily occupied territories. It enables them to pursue further education or secure employment within territories under the control of the Government of Ukraine.
- Approval of **standards** for the operation of temporary residences for internally displaced persons. These standards establish the framework for the formation and management of such facilities, outlining minimum requirements for supporting the livelihood of internally displaced persons.

Major Breakthroughs of 2023

- For internally displaced persons who relocated before February 24, 2022:
 - 1) **Resumption** of the provision of paper pension certificates.
 - 2) Postponement of the identification **deadline**.
 - 3) Extension of the accommodation allowance payment **period**.
- Adoption of the **Procedure** for identifying pensioners by the Pension Fund of Ukraine through video conferencing. These adjustments will facilitate continued pension payments for internally displaced persons receiving pensions through JSC "Oschadbank."
- Improvement of the **Procedure** for issuing training vouchers and an increase in payment for participation in socially beneficial activities. These changes aim to enhance the economic stability of internally displaced persons, particularly in acquiring new professions.


